MAINTAINING THE PERIMETER OF THE DANGER ZONE

- A. Spectators **not permitted** within 200 metre fallout zone, and;
- within 100 metres to the side or behind a high level ramp,
 - within 45 metres of the side or behind a low level ramp,
 - with 35 metres to the side or behind a ground level detonation area.
- B. Ramp **not permitted** within 300 metres of a storage area containing materials that are flammable, explosive and/or toxic, and:
- Within 300 metres of institutional buildings such as a hospital or nursing home
 - Within 100 metres of motor vehicle
