What is "Can I Play Too?"

The "Can I Play Too?" program is designed to assist those families with limited financial resources, for their children ages 3 to 16 to participate in programs offered by the Parks, Facilities, Recreation & Cultural Services. Program registration fees are shared equally between:

1. participant
2. program sponsor (see list below)
3. Recreation & Cultural Services

Who can apply?

Any resident of Welland can apply on behalf of a dependent wishing to take part in any recreation program offered by the City of Welland, Parks, Facilities, Recreation & Cultural Services.

How do I select a program?

How do I apply?

When do I apply?

The program is open year-round, provided that sponsor funds remain available.

How often can I apply?

Applications are completed each season: Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter. You may apply once per season. The application form is completed in strict confidence.
