WELLAND SHUTS OFF THE LIGHTS AND TURNS ON THE CONVERSATION MAR 30, 2019

Welland, ON – The City of Welland is encouraging residents and business owners to participate in the grassroots global Earth Hour movement on Saturday, March 30, 2019, from 8:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Earth Hour is as a symbolic lights-out event that initiated in Sydney in 2007. It is now the world's largest grassroots movement for the environment, inspiring millions of people to take action for our planet and nature. Earth Hour now has 180 countries ready to participate in this year's themed 'Why Nature Matters' carbon reducing hour.

Welland city staff will shut-off all non-essential lighting and energy depleting devices at Welland Civic Square and turn off ice compressors at both arenas during Earth Hour.
