### **Former St. John Ambulance Site Set for Demolition**

**For Immediate Release – November 5, 2008 – 4:30 p.m.**

**Welland** – The City of Welland will be issuing a demolition permit tomorrow for the building recently occupied by St. John Ambulance and formerly owned by the Welland Optimist Club.

Demolition of the 5,598 square foot building located at 70 Elmwood Avenue is expected to begin in the next couple of days. It is expected to take approximately two weeks to raze the building.

Sterling Realty (Niagara) Inc., the current owner of the property and permit holder, has not submitted an application to the City for redevelopment of the site.
